Kedington Horticultural Show 2020

It will be no surprise to anyone reading this that this year's Horticultural Show at St Peter and St Paul Church will be different from previous years. The number of classes will be reduced, but we hope that there will be something for everyone who wishes to take part and an opportunity for others to view the exhibits and purchase home-grown produce.

Please read the rules and schedule below to find out how you can get involved. Watch out for up-to-date information on notice boards and Kedington Community Facebook group. Sadly, it is not possible to have the culinary section this year.

Rules

All entries to be grown or cooked in the parish of Kedington, or by Kedington Church worshippers, or by members of the Kedington Garden Society, or by members of Kedington WI or members of Kedington Uniformed Youth Groups or pupils of Kedington School.

- a. Anyone wishing to enter the Show must register their name, address and phone number with Jill Davis before 6.00pm on 11 September 2020 via telephone 713137 or Facebook Messenger.
- b. Cost 50p per entry.
- Exhibits to be displayed outside, at the front of the property from 12 noon on 12 September 2020.
- d. There is no limit to the number of entries at each property.
- e. A photographer and member of the organising committee will visit all the registered addresses and photograph displays between 12 noon and 3.00pm. Displays will be judged by appearance alone. Entry fees will also be collected when photographs are taken. Strict social distancing will be observed.
- f. On the day, a list of locations where exhibits can be viewed will be on sale at the Church from 1.00pm. Anyone is free to walk around the village, view the displays. They may also purchase produce after it has been photographed.

- g. It will be up to the exhibitors to price their produce and to ensure nothing from their display is sold until after photographs have been taken.
- During the afternoon, we encourage exhibitors to publish photographs of their displays on social media.
- Exhibits not to be removed until after 4.00pm on the 12 September 2020.
- j. The photographs will be sent to the judge.
 Their decision is final.
- k. The results will be available on 19 September 2020.
- When the results are known, the winners will be contacted, and trophies will be presented the week beginning 20 September. Results will be posted on Facebook and in the following edition of the Ketton Review.
- m. There will be no certificates printed this year and no auction of produce.
- Money raised from the sale of maps and entry fees will go towards Church funds.
 We will also happily accept donations of the money raised by the sale of produce.

Note – tomatoes will be judged under the vegetable section even though they are a fruit.

- 4. Three decorated biscuits (judged by appearance only)

- 6. A home-made, decorated card
- 7. A home-made, decorated book-mark

Trophies will be awarded as follows

- a. The Keddy Trophy will be awarded to the entry the judge considers to be the best over all sections.
- b. The Les Moulton Trophy will be awarded to the best display of vegetables.
- c. The Barbara Mouton Trophy will be awarded to the best display of fruit.
- d. The Jeannie Lee Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the best container of six mixed stems of any garden flowers.
- e. The Rose Driscoll Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the best single rose, any variety.
- f. The Mike Driscoll Trophy will be awarded to the exhibit which the judge decides is the best display in the Children's Section.
- g. The Kedington Rocks Trophy will be awarded to the best painted rock.
